Our Fellowship is open to all women and men regardless of age, race, religion (or no religion), ethnic background, marital status or occupation. We welcome anyone to become a member without regard of sexual identity or orientation, whether gay, lesbian, straight, bisexual or transgender.

Our Fellowship is supported through voluntary contributions from members. We are not affiliated with any other twelve-step program. Nor are we a part of any other organization.

We do not support, endorse or oppose outside causes or issues.
